

DONATION GUIDELINES

Donation drop off hours 11 – 4 Tuesday through Saturday

Donations must be delivered at the back door of the building

Donations must be received by a staff member or volunteer. We do this to ensure that donations are usable, appropriate, and saleable. Otherwise, the Thrift Shop is responsible for the disposal of these items and are charged a fee for doing so.

We appreciate that donations be brought inside the building and not left outdoors

We appreciate donations of items that are new, previously enjoyed, free from pet hair/odors, clean, and in good working condition

We welcome:

- Clothing – clean, gently -used for babies, children, ladies and men
- Footwear
- Outdoor gear – work wear, coats, boots, bags, backpacks
- Accessories – jewellery, belts, hats, purses, totes, etc.
- Baby equipment – strollers, high chairs – must meet criteria set out by Federal government
- Housewares – dishes, storage containers, bowls, pots/pans, utensils
- Small appliances – toasters, mixers, crock pots, vacuums, blow dryers
- Home Décor – wall art, ornaments, collectibles, mirrors, seasonal décor, clocks
- Crafts, including fabric
- Games, toys
- Books, Records, DVDs, games
- Office items – paper, office supplies, file trays, calculators, telephones
- Linens – bedding, towels, throw rugs, curtains, kitchen linens
- Sporting goods – skates, golf clubs, bags etc.
- Small furniture – side tables, lamps, bookshelves, small desks,
- Small tools
- Electronics – stereos, computer accessories, calculators

Sorry, we are not able to accept the following due to safety regulations and limitations on our storage capacity:

- Beds – mattresses/box spring, futons, hide a beds,
- Hazardous materials – paint, cleaning supplies, aerosols, propane
- Large carpets
- Window blinds with cords
- Living room/kitchen furniture – sofas, recliners, china cabinets, table/chair sets
- Outdoor furniture – patio sets
- Large appliances – fridges, stoves, washers, dryers
- Large exercise equipment – treadmills
- Baby furniture/equipment – car seats, beds, gates
- Larger Building supplies – large light fixtures, plumbing supplies, toilets, sinks
- Cosmetics/health & beauty supplies
- Undergarments – (unless new, in original unopened packaging)
- Gas powered products
- Garden equipment – gas powered mowers, BBQs, propane tanks,
- Bikes
- Safety equipment and products with an expiry date eg. Helmets
- Food items
- Toys – stuffed/cloth toys
- Books – textbooks/encyclopedias
- Christmas trees (unless in original, unopened packaging)
- Incomplete sets of cards, board games, puzzles, etc.
- Flooring
- Car parts, tires
- Pianos, large musical instruments
