We have trained, educated professional dedicated staff who offer multi-level support to those who are accessing our services. From educational support to a shoulder to lean on.

Our Family Support Workers Provide pre/postnatal information, community referrals, and we have a doula/lactation consultant who can assist with your pre/postnatal needs.

Our Home Visitation Workers can come to you in the comfort of your own home!

We provide free transportation to the Bridge Network Outreach School, our office, and our support groups

We offer free counselling with a mental health professional through a partnership with Alberta Health Services.
